Drainage Review Submittal Check List:

Site Development Submittals To Include:

- 90% complete plans including all proposed construction features
- Location map showing location of the site
 - Site Plan showing proposed improvements
 - Grading and earthwork showing existing topography
 - Drainage area map and drainage plan
 - Approximate location of floodplain if site is within the floodplain
 - Other items as required in Section 1.3.1 of the Wharton County Drainage Criteria Manual
 - Existing and proposed direction of overland flow
 - Drainage studies and/or calculations
 - Area and depths of proposed fill if any
 - Proposed pond/detention facility capacity and location

Pipeline Project Submittals To Include:

- Plan and profiles with location of the floodplain shown
- Location(s) of above ground improvements
- Details on above ground improvements and drainage crossings
- Proposed mitigation for improvements that adversely affect drainage or floodplain
- Hydraulic modeling may be required if improvements are proposed in a drainage or floodplain

All review comments shall be addressed in the resubmittals or written responses provided.
