THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that the said Principal will make payment to the County of Wharton, Texas of and for any and all damages that may be sustained to any highway or bridge under the jurisdiction of the County of Wharton, Texas by virtue of the operation of any equipment by the said Principal, for which a permit is issued to operate under the provisions of Transportation Code, Section 623.018.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall pay to the County of Wharton, Texas any and all damages that may be sustained to any road as above recited by virtue of the operation of any equipment under the provisions of the law referred to above during a period beginning with the date of this bond and ending _____, 2_____, then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue of Law.
